

Derwentwater is the third largest of the Cumbrian Lakes and is three miles long and one and a half miles wide.

At its deepest point it measures seventy five feet although its average depth is fifteen feet. Derwentwater was used as one of the filming locations for Swallows and Amazons (1974 & 2016) and a recent famous sci-fi film (see map). Our Launch 'Lady Derwentwater' was used as the houseboat in the 1974 version of 'Swallows and Amazons'.

Derwentwater is unusual in that it has four islands: Derwent, Lords, Rampsholme and St. Herbert's, dotted along its length. Derwent Isle was once the home of German miners working in the area and St. Herbert's Island was named after the saint who lived there as a hermit.

Our launches sail from Keswick, calling at six landing stages around Derwentwater on request (please stand on the end of the landing stage and wave if you require launch to stop).

1. Keswick

Our launches depart from this stage. Cabin cruisers and rowing boats for hire.

2. Ashness Gate

/// nimbly.laugh.childcare

Ashness Bridge, Surprise View and Watendlath are all well worth the walk from this landing stage.

3. Lodore

/// thousands.cotton.candles

Lodore waterfalls and a good selection of hotels and places to eat and drink in the Borrowdale Valley are all within walking distance.

4. High Brandelhow

/// cotton.footpath.points

For a relaxing walk through Low Manesty Woods. The first tract of land ever bought by the National Trust in 1904.

5. Low Brandelhow

/// trendy.reports.peach

Brandelhow Park is a delightful mixture of woodland, fields and wetland, which provides an excellent habitat for local wildlife.

6. Hawse End

/// party.peach.contexts

A very popular landing stage for walkers who head for Catbells and the beautiful Newlands Valley.

7. Nichol End

/// bogus.watch.snacks

Marina and a short walk from Portinscale Village.

The Lingholm Estate

There is no Launch jetty at Lingholm, go via our Hawse End Jetty

Newly refurbished with brand new café/restaurant and octagonal garden. Lingholm was built by Alfred Waterhouse in the 1870s and was a favourite holiday spot for Beatrix Potter. The garden was a direct inspiration for Mr McGregor's garden in The Tale of Peter Rabbit. To visit the Lingholm estate, take the Launch to Hawse End, then take the path through the woods 15 - 20 minutes walk to the north. Return to Hawse End to take the Launch back to Keswick.

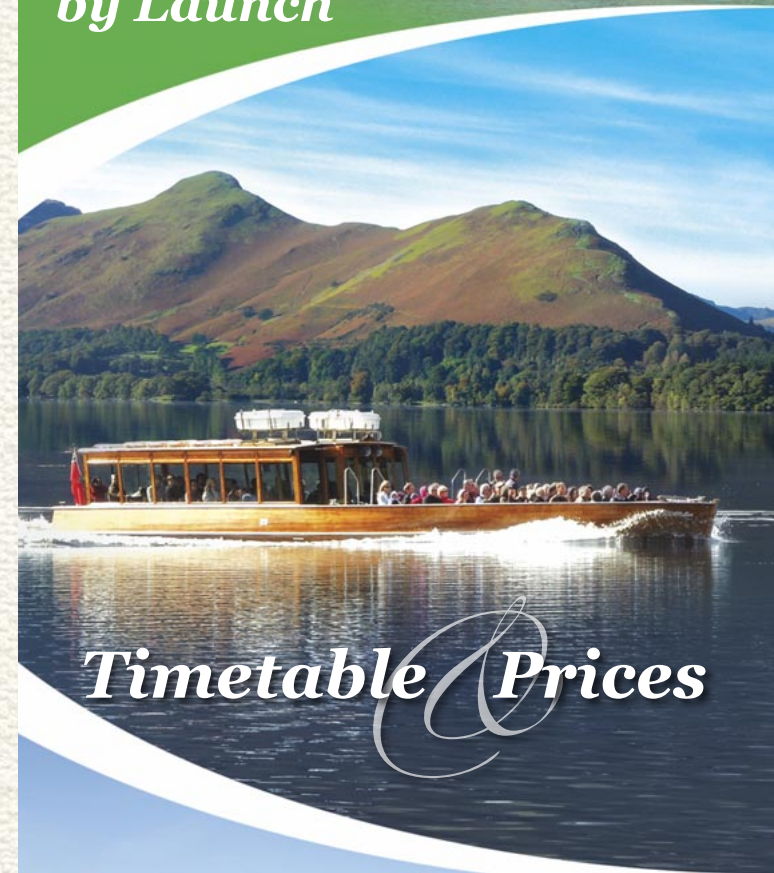
